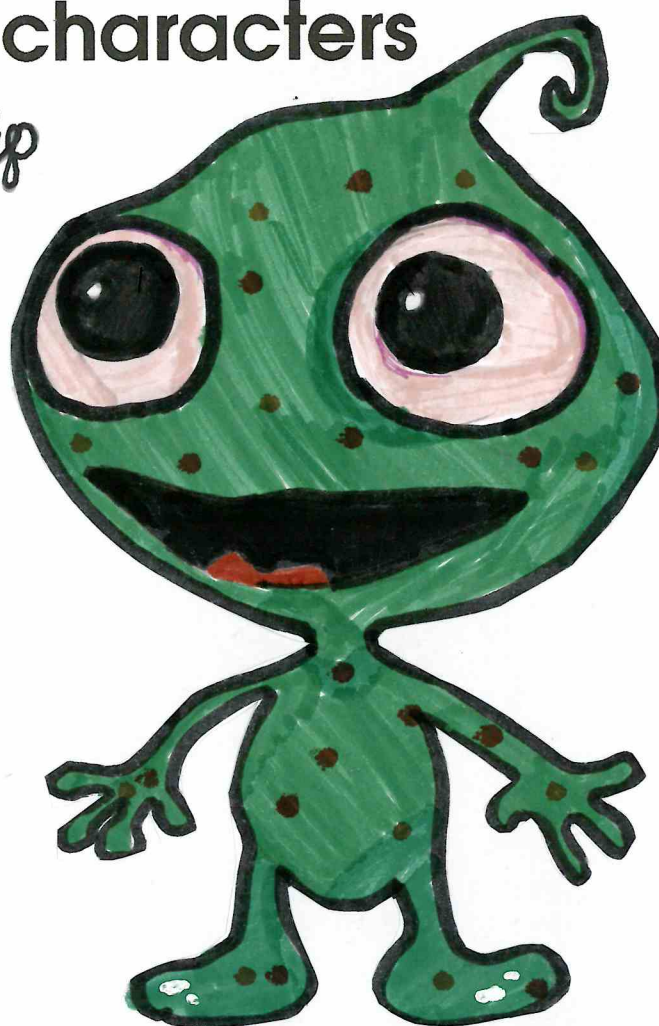

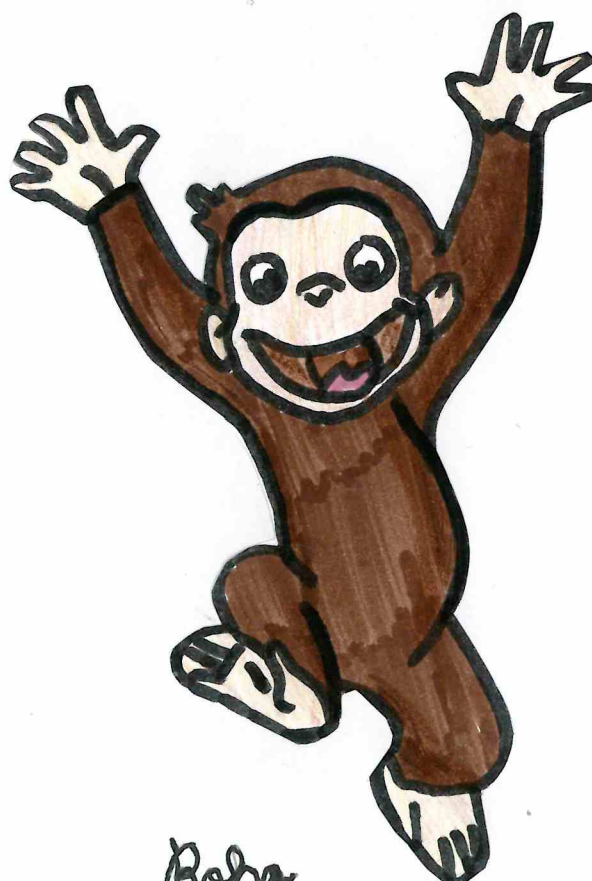

see us.*

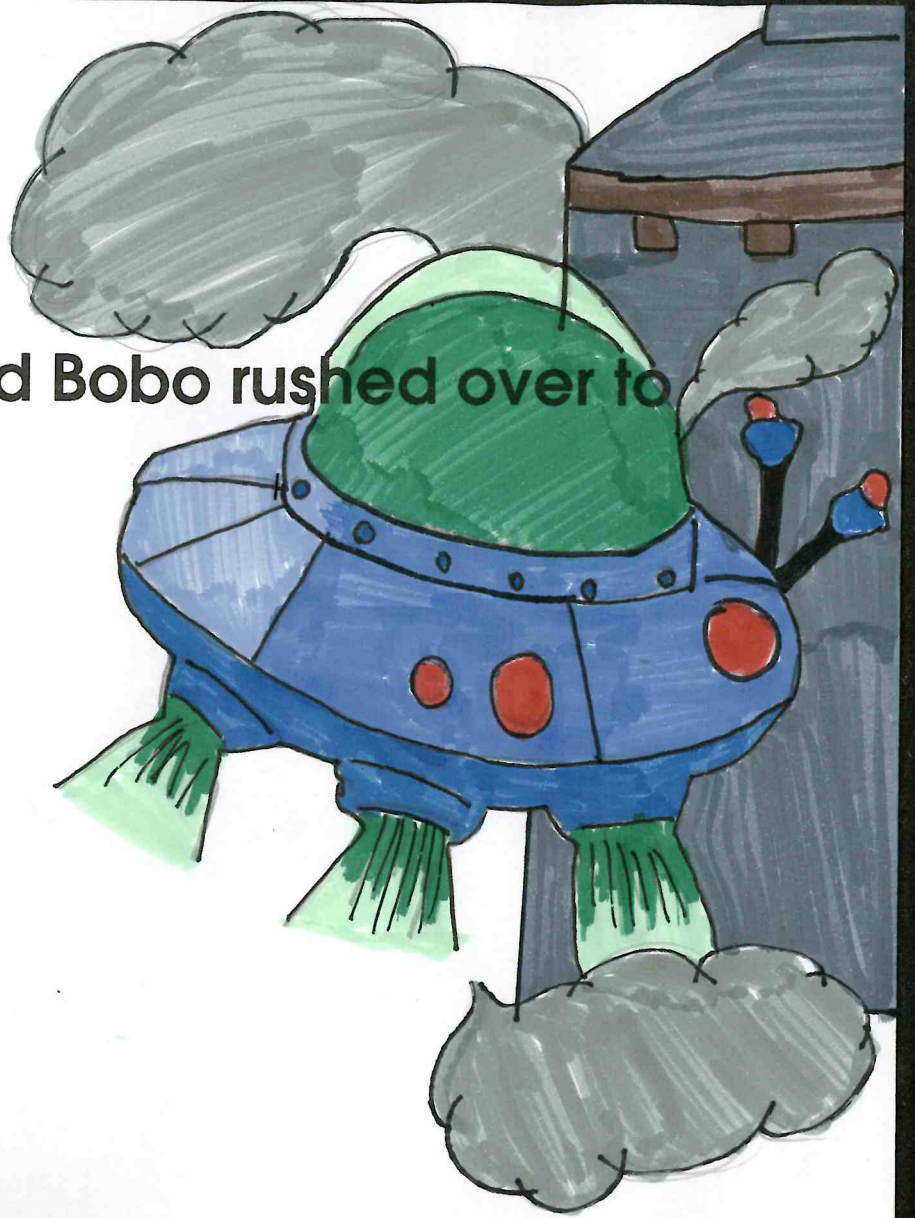

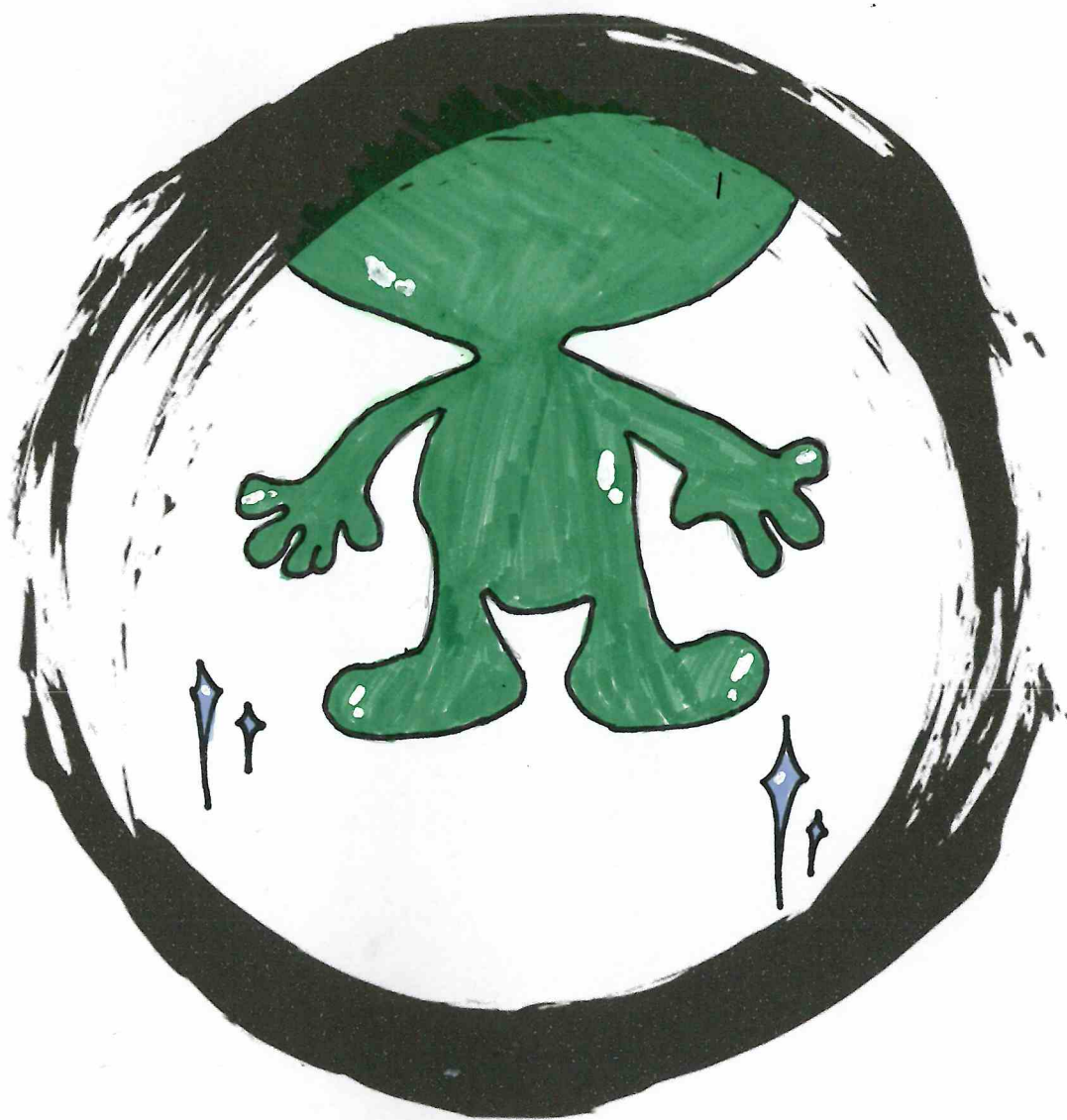

Zahra, Nikita and Bobo rushed over to the spaceship.

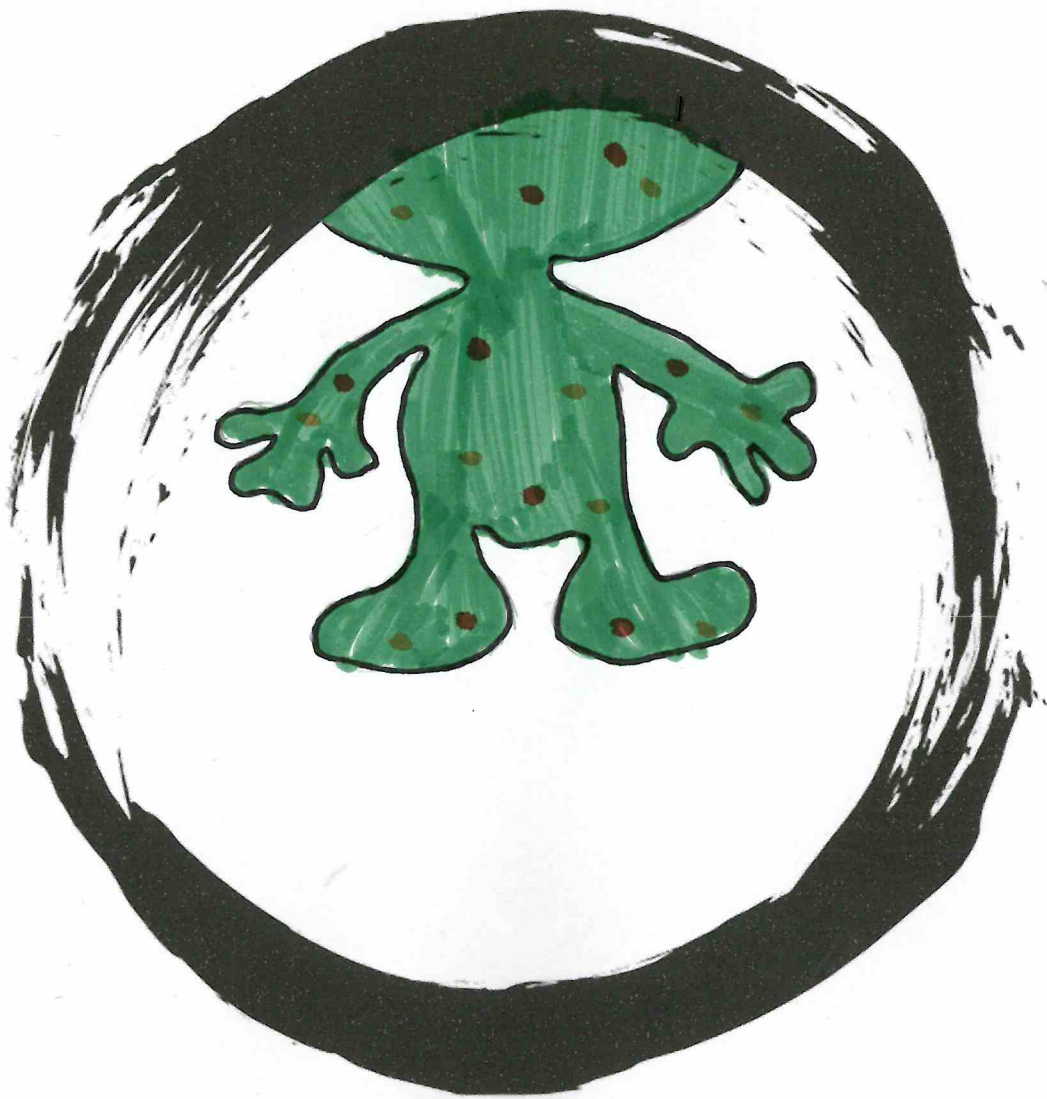


As the three of them stood there, Chip slowly emerged from the smoking spaceship.

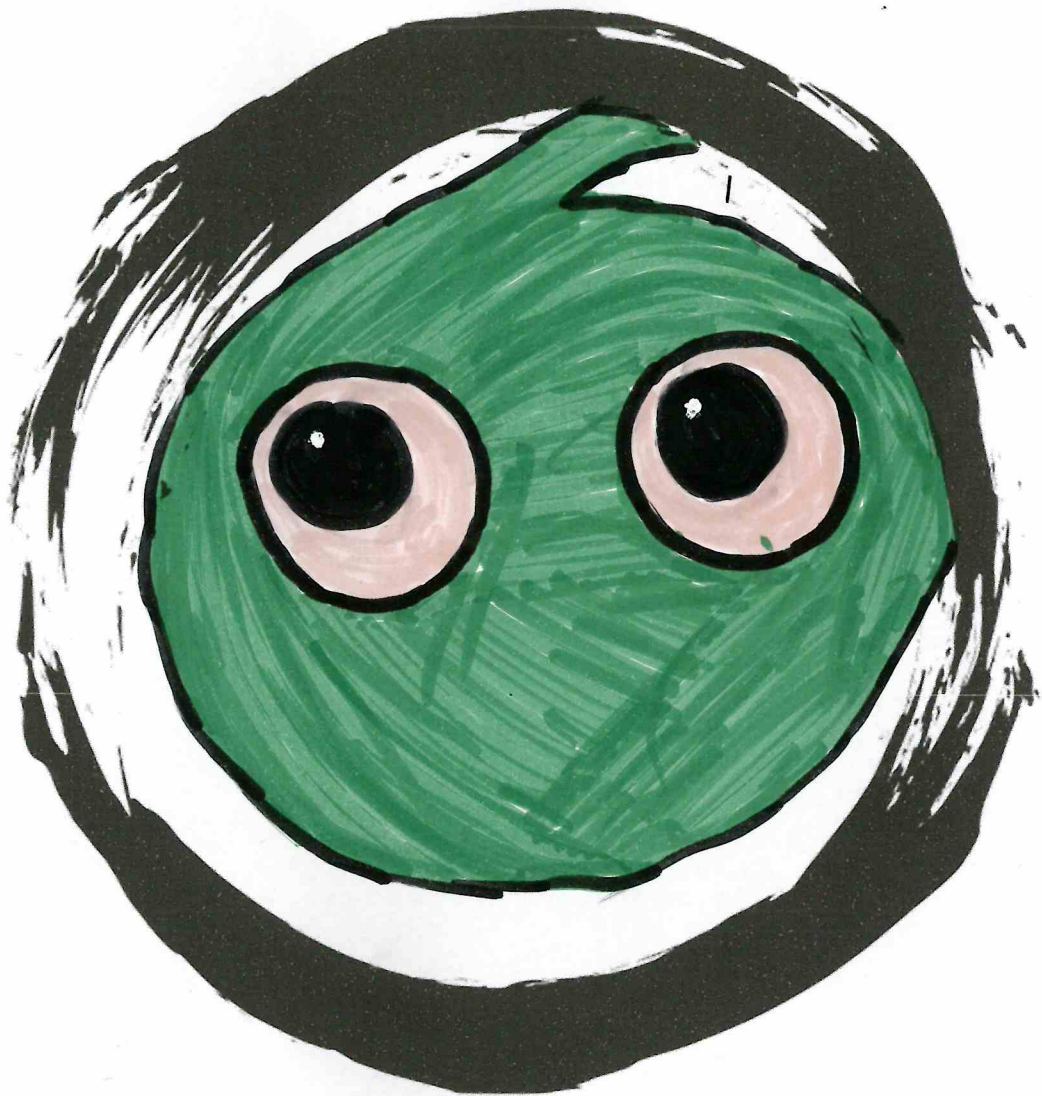




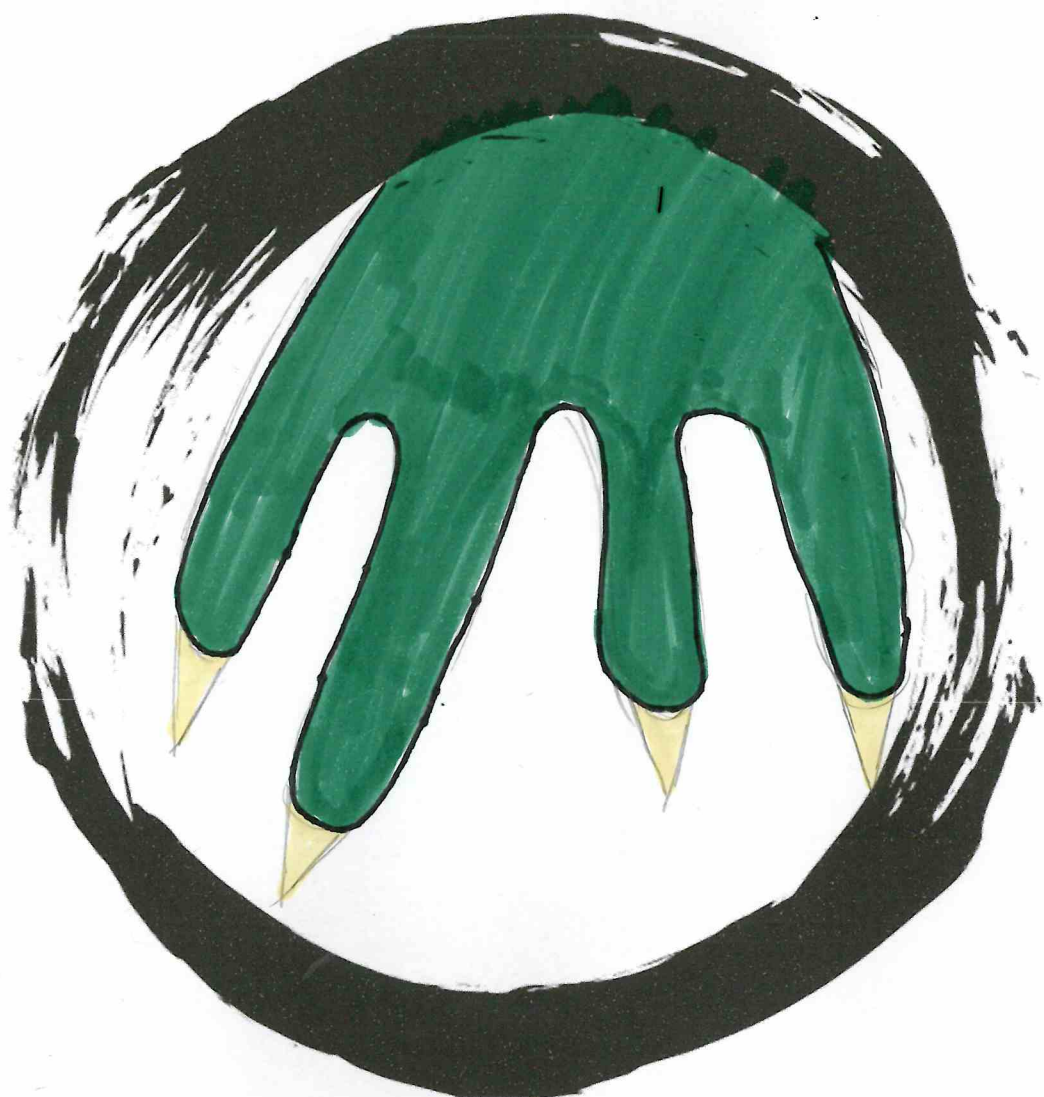
He had sparkly bright green skin



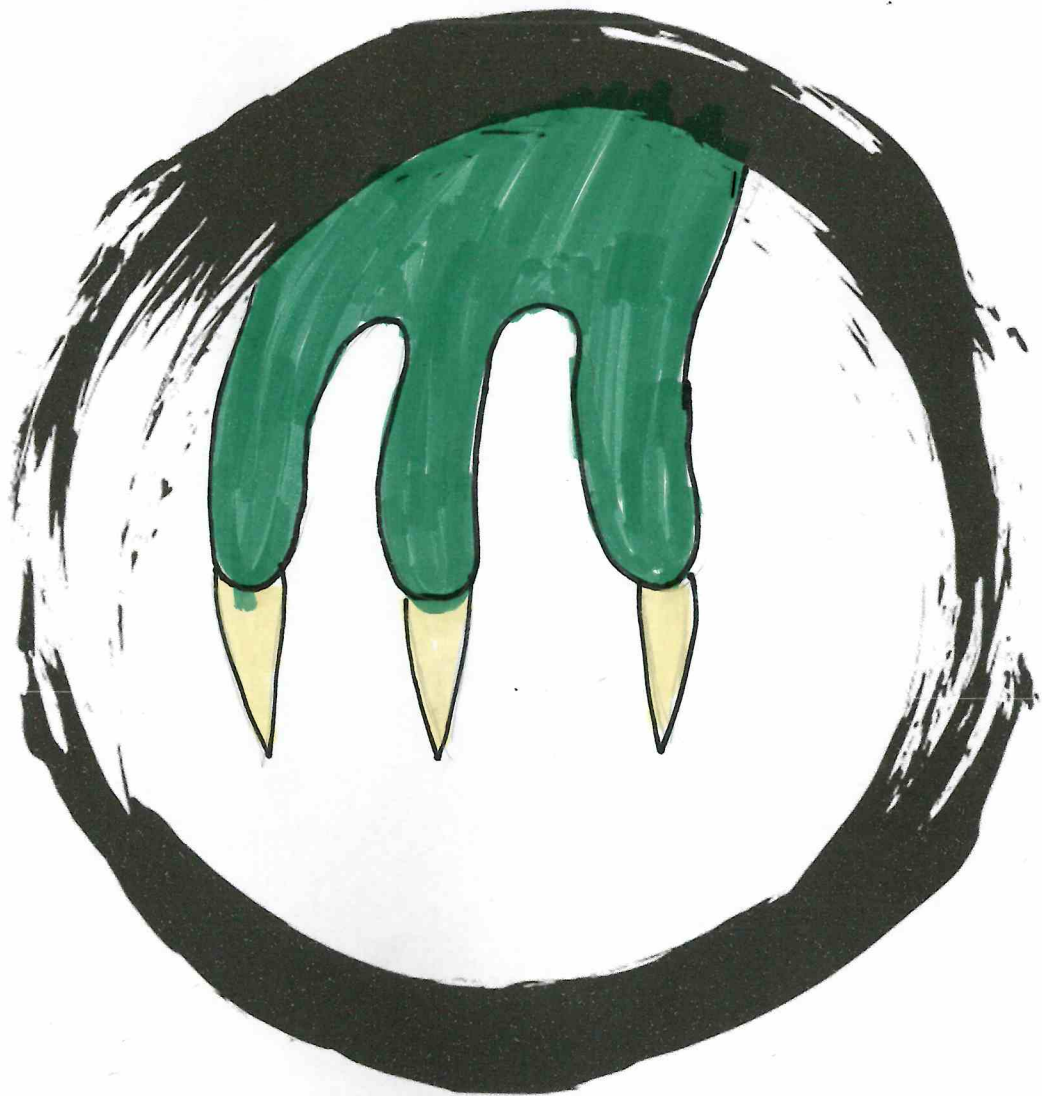

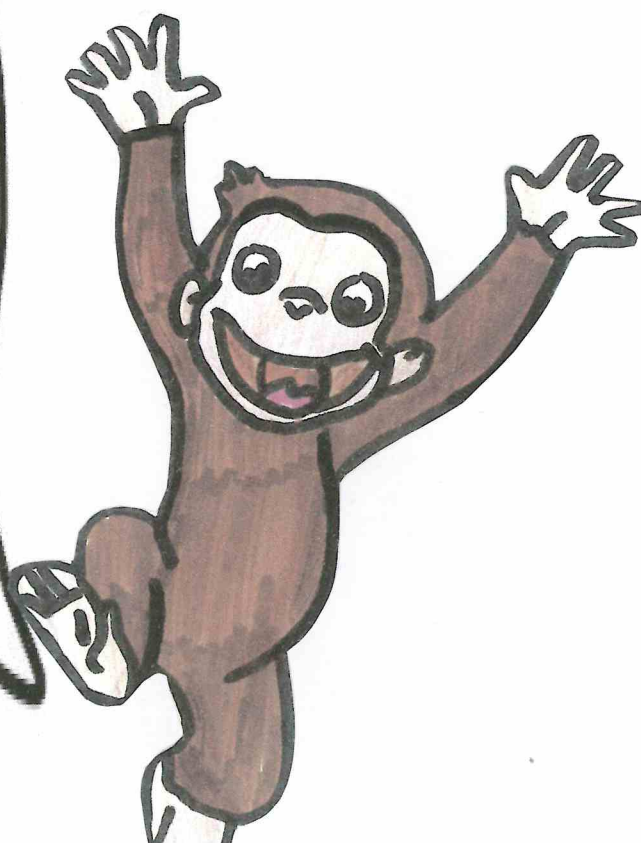

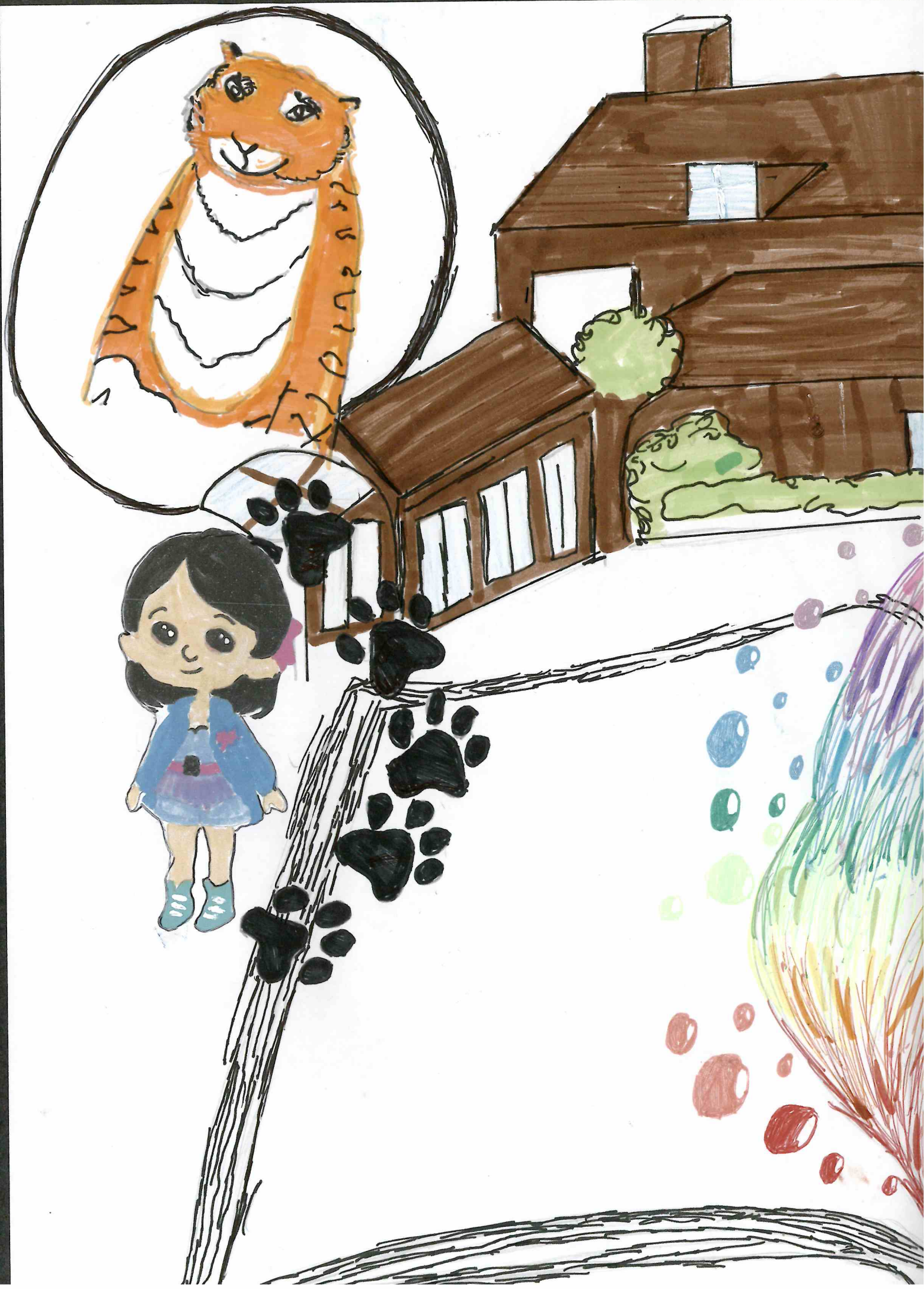
"They are found in a special place beyond the pages of this book," he announced, "In a place called Alexandra Primary School."

Nikita and Zahra gasped! Tales of characters leaving their books and entering the real world were considered myths - no one could recall any characters - who had *actually* done that...

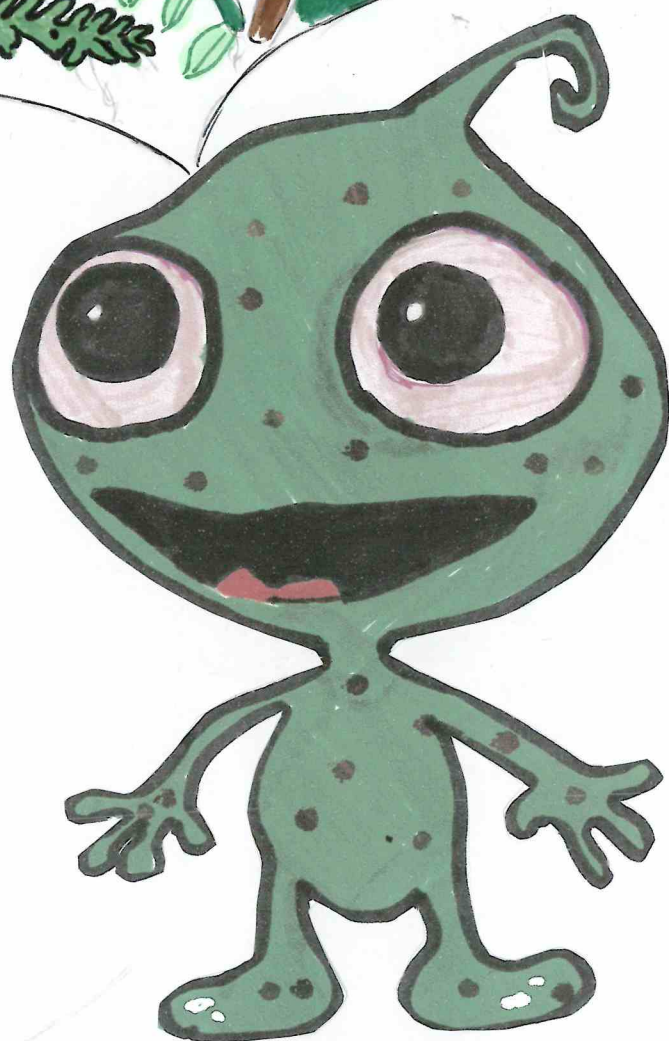

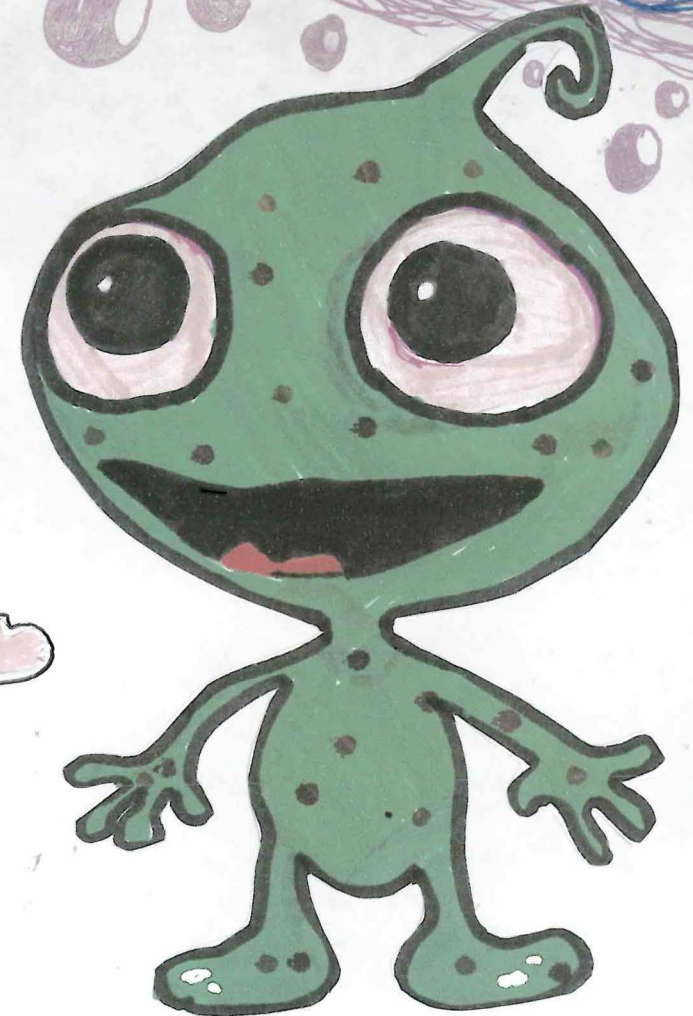
Nikita shouted, feeling surprised but thrilled by the adventure.

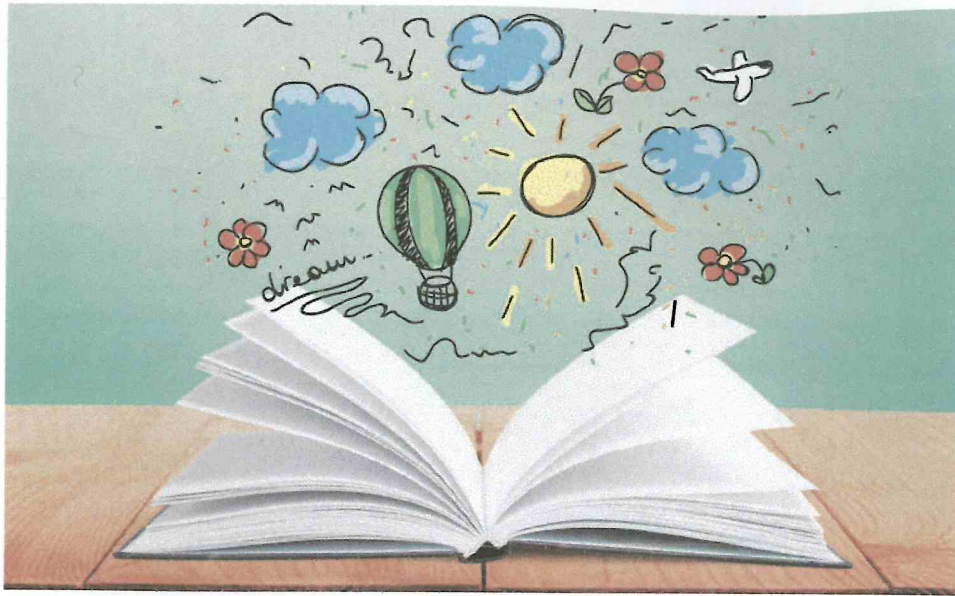
These were definitely the best readers in the world!
