


Early Years Home Learning

Literacy		Maths	
<p>Encourage your child to talk in longer sentences. A great way to do this is by modelling sentences to them. For example, if your child requests "water" you can model saying "Can I have a drink of water please?".</p>		<p><i>Positional language:</i> Through our story this week you can use the vocabulary to describe the position of the goats and the troll. Can you use the words 'on' 'over' 'under' and 'next to' when you are playing together?</p>	
Phonics			
<p>Alliteration – Play 'I spy with my little eye' spotting objects that begin with the same sound. For example, sun, sign, soap, sponge etc.</p>		<p>You can also focus on recognising the numbers 1,2 and 3.</p>	
		Topic	
		<p>Can you build a bridge using a construction toy that you have at home?</p> 	
		<p><i>Independence</i> – Please encourage your child to put on and remove their own coats. This week you could also focus on them doing their own zips up.</p> <p><i>Balance</i> – Encourage your child to balance on one leg. You could make it into a challenge – How long can you balance for?</p>
