


Early Years Home Learning

		<p>All children have developed their independence since joining Nursery. Please use this isolation period to develop their independent dressing. You now have the time for child to get dressed on their own. Place their clothes out for them and encourage them to independently remove and put on their own clothes. Talk about the order we put clothes on. Do we need to put our t-shirt or jumper on first? This will help them physically and increase their confidence.</p>
