

Dear Nursery,

We will focus on adjusting speed and changing direction when running. You could play a game with them to practise this next time you visit an open space. For example, tag, stuck in the mud, north-east-south-west.</p>

<p>The skill of retelling is important for children. Ask your child to recall certain events, can they tell you what happened first, next and last?</p>	<p><i>Comparing quantities:</i> Can you look at two groups of objects and say when they both have the same amount?</p> 	<p>Together you can watch some videos of bears in their natural environment.
