





# Early Years Weekly Overview

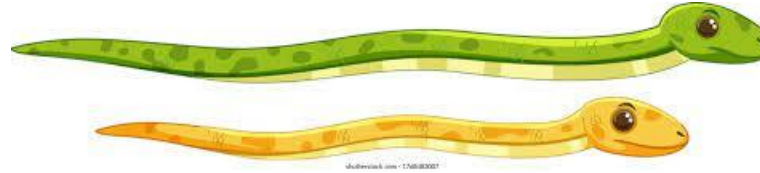
