<p>Encourage your child to sing the nursery rhyme Incy Wincy Spider</p>	<p>Counting – encourage your child to count in sequence to 10.</p>	<p>Can you find out some fun spider facts together?</p> <p>You could go on a spider web hunt. Where do spiders like to make webs?</p>

<p>Exploring with sounds – using everyday objects at home encourage your child to explore sounds (pots, pans, spoons etc, rice in a bottle etc.)</p>
