This week our topic is: 'Street Detectives'		
Personal, Social and Emotional development	Communication and Language	Physical Development
Play a game with your child. Take on a role and snatch the toy, or refuse to share. Talk to your child about this behaviour and encourage them to suggest how to play nicely and compromise and/or share. Ask them to teach you how to play nicely.	Enjoy listening to the story together 'A house is a house for me'. If you are outside in the garden or going to the park, stay warm by running, skipping hopping and moving in different ways. Going outside will help reinforce last week's task of children putting on their own coat and gloves. If you are inside put on some music and dance. Encourage your child to dance to the rhythm of the music and make up their own dance.

Literacy	Maths	Topic
Hear your child read daily. There are Bug Club books (although limited in number - they can be reread to support fluency). There are also additional reading materials suggested in Google classroom to complete.	Play games using fingers: Play quick fire finger games. "show me 3" "show me another way to make 3". Aim for your child to respond at speed. When confident at representing 3 in different ways repeat the activity for 4 and 5 fingers.	We are starting our new topic 'Street Detectives' and this half term we will be learning about different types of buildings. When you go for a walk look at the different buildings you pass. Talk about what type of building you can see e.g. a house, a semi-detached house, a terraced house, a flat, a shop, a doctor's surgery etc. Talk about some features of the property, doors, windows, roof. Why does the property have a number on it?
<b>Phonics</b>		
Look at the Home Learning phonics and practise the new phase 3 sounds to enable your child to recall the sounds j, v, w, x, y, z, qu, ch at speed.
