This half term our topic is: 'I am Unique'		
Personal, Social and Emotional development	Communication and Language	Physical Development
This week we have listened to the story 'The Very Helpful Hedgehog'. Encourage your child to be helpful at home and praise them for their efforts. Explain how being helpful supports others and makes others feel happy. Ask your child how they feel when they are being helpful too.	Encourage your child to listen and enjoy stories. Read their school library book to them. Share and talk about their favourite part of the story.	Provide children with opportunities to move freely and refine their moving skills. Go to the park and encourage them to run, skip and climb safely and to enjoy physical exercise.

Literacy	Maths	Topic
Using the phoneme cards in the plastic wallet, bring sounds together to make words i.e. c-a-t (cat) d-i-p (dip) c-o-t (cot). Encourage your child to say the phonemes and blend to read the words. Hear your child read their reading books. Make a comment in the Reading Log to let the class teacher know how they responded to the reading.	We are learning about the meaning of number 1. Go on a number hunt, can you find number 1 when walking around Hounslow? For example, on car number plates, on houses, in the shops. Explain that numbers have meanings i.e. 1p piece, 1 on the TV changer or 1 on a birthday card.	As half term approaches and the weather changes visit the park and talk about the changes all around. Look at the changing colours of the leaves. Notice the different shapes of leaves. Question why are there leaves on the floor. Collect pine cones and conkers and leaves. Can you create a piece of art work with these materials?
Phonics		
Using the phoneme cards sent home in the plastic wallet, practise recalling the sounds (not the letter names) of each of the letters. Learn to instantly recall the tricky words.
