# Routes and through flow to promote social distancing for Reception aged children

Parents, when coming onto the school site, please follow these protocols to promote social distancing and the avoidance of gatherings to keep yourselves, children and staff safe during these challenging times. We are staggering start and finish times for Reception, Y1 and Y6.

## When dropping your child off between 9:30am and 9:45am – Reception aged children

- Enter school via the pedestrian gate from Denbigh Road.
- Use the path to go to the Reception path gate drop your child at the first gate and move to the Tiverton Road exit.
- You will not be able to enter the school via the main school office.
- All communication will be via telephone or email, unless unwell children are being collected
- If you need to drop or collect items, please do this from the box by the main entrance please ensure all items are clearly named and if possible placed in a zip lock bag.



When collecting your child at the end of the school between at 2:15 to 2:30pm.

- Enter school via the pedestrian gate from Denbigh Road.
- Use the path to the Reception path gate. Please wait on the line at collection time.
- Leave the school promptly through the **Tiverton Road exit**. Please respect the one-way system.
- If you need to speak to a teacher, telephone or email the school.
- If you need to drop or collect items, please do this from the box by the main entrance please ensure all items are clearly named and if possible placed in a zip lock bag.

#### Points to note:

- Please leave more time for your journey
- One parent with child(ren) please
- If you have to bring siblings with you that are not in one of the year groups allowed back to school, please ensure that you have spoken to them about this and they are under your control at all times. None of the play equipment is to be used.
- If at any point you or your child has symptoms, do not bring them into school. You will not be able to see the welfare officer and you should follow the advice for self-isolation.
- There will be no car parking on site.

Please adhere to these protocols at all times to ensure the safety of all concerned.
