Your teacher will check and sign your planner once a week.

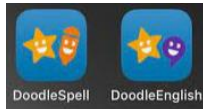
Over the Summer holiday, aim to read different text genres such as: a biography, stories, poems and newspapers.

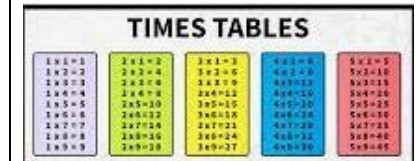
Take part in the weekly Year 2 Battle of the Bands!
