Let's travel back, way back, 2.6 million years ago to prehistoric times!

We are very excited to get stuck into our first topic of Year 3: The Stone Age to the Iron Age (in Britain). We will be exploring evidence and archaeological findings to build a picture of life back then.

To prepare you for your learning in September, we would like you to choose one or more of these activities to complete as part of your Summer homework.









1. Choose an aspect of life in the Stone Age to research and find out more about (for example: clothes, shelter, hunting, tools, animals). Write an information text about this subject. Alternatively, you could create an information poster about your chosen topic. Here is a link to get you started with your research!

2. Think about your life now. How do you think life in the Stone Age might have been different? Write at least 5 questions that you would like to ask a person from the Stone Age! Use a different heading for each question you ask. e.g. Houses, Food, Jobs, Writing, Art.
3. If you could give something from 2021 to people from the Stone Age to improve their life, what would you give them? Draw a picture of your chosen item (or items) and use complete sentences to explain why you have chosen them.
4. Make up your own story. It can be about anything you like but it must be told using ONLY pictures, just like in the Stone Age!
5. Complete the wordsearch below. **Challenge:** Find out what all of the words mean and write down a definition for each one.
