What are your hobbies? What traditions are important to you? What makes you happy? You can even incorporate some of the themes in option A. You may wish to display this in a box.</p> <p>You could create a video presentation about your culture or perform a song or a dance from your culture and talk about it.</p> <p>Be as creative as you like! Any patterns/designs/artwork you use could be reflective of your culture or identity.</p>
