Design a new building which is capable of surviving a specific natural event.

You could create a model, draw your design, use a computer program or any other way that you can think of to present your ideas. Label the materials you would use and why these would be useful.

### Activity 6

Imagine you have been told that a natural disaster (earthquake, tsunami, tornado) is about to hit your town.  
What would you take?
