


# Weekly Creative Home Learning

What do you need help with?</p> <p>'I am good at riding my bike but I need help making my breakfast'.</p>	<p>Read the story 'Growing frogs' by Vivien French. The book is about the life cycle of the frog. Was the frog able to jump at the beginning? Was she able to jump at the end? Discuss the different phases the frog went through.          Talk about yourself; can you do things now, that you could not do before?          Make a zig-zag book (see picture below) about the things you can do now. Use sentences such as "I can.....", "I am good at....."</p> <p>Draw a picture of yourself on the front cover! We can't wait to see your books on our website!
