<p>Read the story 'Harry and the Dinosaurs go wild' with your parents  <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=trAznl3u56U">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=trAznl3u56U</a>            Ask your child questions about the story.            Why did Harry get upset? What did he decide to do? Why did he stick his pictures in his window? Why did the shop keeper call him? How did he help endangered animals?</p> <p><b>Bug Club</b> - Read a new book on bug club! We can check how many books you have read so we can add more if you need. Do make sure you have clicked on every bug and answered all the questions fully. Otherwise the computer thinks you have not finished and we are not able to give you a new book. Please do not read 5 or 6 books a day as there is a limited supply of books available.</p>	<p>Read the story 'Harry and the Dinosaurs go wild' (see reading).  <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=trAznl3u56U">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=trAznl3u56U</a>            In the story Harry makes posters to save the endangered animals. Could you help to save the animals too?            Think of your favourite endangered animal, make a poster encouraging people to save them, just like Harry did.            Take a picture of your poster and post onto the school gallery. Remember your name and class!</p> <p><a href="mailto:apsallstars@alexandra.hounslow.sch.uk">apsallstars@alexandra.hounslow.sch.uk</a></p>	<p>Introduce the word <b>double</b>.            Watch the BBC Numberblocks Series 2 Episode 9 – double Trouble.</p> <p>Sit opposite your child, set out a small quantity of items such as pebbles, lego cubes, raisins etc. Set out a few items ie 3 cubes – your child matches by setting out another 3 cubes – We can therefore say that double 3 is 6. Repeat with other objects and amounts. Fingers could also be used.</p>  <p>Using a piece of paper – fold in half and then open up. Paint some dots on one side – fold and find how many dots are there. Eg double 3 is, double 4 is etc</p>  <p>Explain that using a mirror will double the number of objects that you have. Using a range of objects place on paper and place a mirror</p>	<p>Think about creative activities.            You could try to draw a turtle or a lizard.
